## Special Prizes

Best score by a **Senior** i.e. 60 years or over on 1 Aug 2020 £25  
 Best score by a **Junior** i.e. under 16 years on 1 Aug 2020 £25  
 To be eligible for the Junior or Senior prize players must have received total prize money of less than £50.

In the event of a tie, trophies will be awarded to the players with the highest sum of progressive scores. Further ties will be decided by head to head results and then the sum of opponents' scores.

The **Kent Champion** title and trophy in each section will be awarded to the highest placed Kent player.  
 The **Kent Ladies Champion** title in each section will be awarded to the highest placed Kent lady.  
 The **Oyster Shield** will be awarded to the highest placed Senior Thanet League player in the Intermediate & Minor sections. **A minimum score of 2.5 points** is required for all awards.

## Information

### Arbiter: Michael Flatt

In any dispute, the Arbiter's decision will be final.

### Rate of play

90 minutes per player for all moves plus a 30 second increment starting from move one. All moves are to be recorded

### Late arriving: more than 30 minutes

Such players will be deemed to have lost by default unless the Arbiter can re-pair them satisfactorily. Players whose opponents are late arriving please report to the Arbiter for re-pairing.

### Withdrawing

Players wishing to withdraw should inform a congress official beforehand.

### Bye option

For rounds 1, 2, 3 or 4, one half-point bye is available, provided this is requested at the time of entry.

### Late entry

Late entries will be paired at the Arbiter's discretion. **Entries on the day - cash only please – will carry a £10 surcharge.**

### Ungraded player prizes

The maximum prize money that can be won by any ungraded player playing in the Challengers, Major, Intermediate or Minor tournaments will be limited to 50% of any prize won.

### ECF Grand Prix

This congress participates in the ECF Grand Prix.

### Accommodation & Parking

There are many hotels and guest houses in the area. Go to [www.visitthanet.co.uk](http://www.visitthanet.co.uk) for details. Accommodation should be booked early as Broadstairs can be very busy in August. There is ample free parking at the venue.

### Train & Bus Services

Regular fast train services run from St Pancras to Broadstairs.

*The organisers reserve the right to vary competition limits in the light of entry response. The organisers may refuse any entry, vary the prize money in the light of entry response or transfer a player to a different section. By entering the competition participants agree to the listing of their grade, name and club on the congress website and to be contacted and advised by email of future congress events.*

## Additional ECF Pay to Play fees

The entry fees are for players who are current ECF members at silver, gold or platinum level on the date of entry. The congress is charged a pay to play grading fee by the ECF of £9.00 for adult and junior players. Thus, non-ECF adult and Junior members and ECF Bronze adult members must pay an additional £9.00 entry fee.
